

Safeguarding Concern Reporting Procedure

Children and Young People

Anyone who is concerned about the wellbeing of a child or young person or has a disclosure of abuse or neglect made to them must:

Report

You have a concern about a child/young person (including mental health concerns) or have a disclosure of abuse or neglect made to you

Refer

If someone is in immediate danger

Call the emergency services (999)

Speak to your Welfare Officer if you have one, if you don't, or they are not available, you can call the Parkour UK Safeguarding Lead 07503743852 or Childline (24/7) 0800 11 11

Inform the parent/carer of the concern, unless you believe it will put the child or yourself at risk

If someone is not in immediate danger

If not available

Seek advice from your local children's social care, the police or NSPCC on 0808 800 5000/Childline on 0800 11 11

Record

Write an objective account of the concerns (ask open questions, not closed or leading questions and reflect back to clarify what the person has said to ensure that you haven't misunderstood) immediately using the Parkour UK Safeguarding Report Form. Send it to the Welfare Officer (if there is one) and Parkour UK Safeguarding Lead within 48 hours of the concern/ disclosure

Triage

The Parkour UK Safeguarding team will triage the concern and decide the next action. Initial support or advice may be sought from third party organisations such as Sport Resolutions, and their Case Management process followed.
